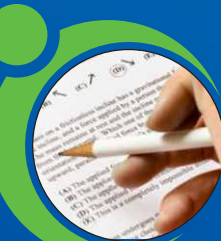

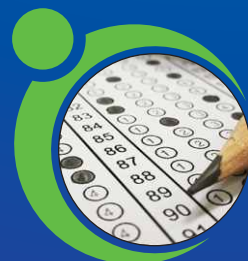

SSC CGL EXAMINATION

The Staff Selection Commission (SSC) conducts the Combined Graduate Level (CGL) Exam for the recruitment of Grade "B" and "C" category posts in various Government Ministries, Departments and Offices (Assistant / Inspector / SI / Statistical Investigator / Auditor / Accountant / Compiler) for Which graduation from a recognized University is the minimum Educational Qualification required. The recruitment for these posts is done in departments like Central Secretariat Service / central Vigilance Commission / Intelligence Bureau / Ministry of Railways / Ministry of External Affairs / Ministry of Defence / CBI and a few other Ministries / Departments / Organizations of the Central Government. . The exam is held in 4 stages called Tiers. While the first two are online the latter two are offline exams. The entire process of registration and communication happens online through the official website of SSC CGL. Candidates must qualify each stage of the SSC CGL exam to proceed to the next one, before being finally selected.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The eligibility criteria for SSC CGL 2019 have three important features:-

1. Educational Qualification: The educational qualification varies according to the post for SSC CGL and is listed below

SSC CGL Post	Educational Qualification
Assistant Audit Officer	Bachelor's Degree in any subject from a recognized University OR Desirable Qualification: CA/CS/MBA/ Cost & Management Accountant/ Masters in Commerce/ Masters in Business Studies
Statistical Investigator Grade – II Post	Bachelor's Degree from any recognized University with minimum 60% in Mathematics in Class 12th OR Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with Statistics as one of the subjects in graduation
Compiler Posts	Bachelor's Degree from any recognized University with Economics or Statistics or Mathematics as compulsory or Elective Subject
All Other Posts	Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized University or equivalent

2. Age

Category of Posts	Age Limit
Assistant in IB	21- 27 Years
Assistant Section Officer / SI in CBI	20 – 30 years
Statistical Investigator Grade II	Maximum 32 years
Asst. Enforcement Officer / Asst. Audit Office / SI in NIA	Maximum 30 years
Tax Assistant CBEC	20 – 27 years
All other Posts	18 – 27 years



DETAIL OF POSTS:

Posts have been placed in two groups, Group – B and Group – C. The pay band for the posts under Group is Rs. 9300 – Rs.34800 and for Group – C is Rs.5200 to Rs.20,200.

Posts under Group B:

- 1. Assistant:** For Ministry, Department or Office of Central Vigilance Commission, Intelligence Bureau, Ministry of Railway, Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), other Ministries / Departments / Organisations.
- 2. Assistant Section Officer** in Office of Central Secretariat Service (CSS)
- 3. Inspector:** For CBDT, CBEC, Department of Post and Central Bureau of Narcotics.
- 4. SI** in CBI, NIA.
- 5. Assistant Enforcement Officer** in Directorate of Enforcement Department of Revenue.
- 6. Divisional Accountant:** For Offices under the CAG.
- 7. Statistical Investigator Grade II:** For Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation.
- 8. Assistant Audit Officer:** For Indian Audit & Accounts Dept, under the CAG.

Posts under Group C:

- 1. Auditor:** Offices under the C & AG, CGDA, CGA and others.
- 2. Accountant / Junior Accountant / Senior Secretariat Assistant;** Officer under C & AG, CGA and others, Central Govt. Offices and Ministries.
- 3. Tax Assistant:** CBDT, CBEC.
- 4. Compiler** Registrar General of India.
- 5. Sub Inspector:** Central Bureau of Narcotics.

EXAM PATTERN:

The Examination Comprises four Stages as enumerated below:

TIER – 1 (Computer Based): SSC - CGL exam will be conducted online comprising of 4 sections with about a 100 questions in total and with maximum marks of 200. The entire exam is needed to be completed in a time span of 60 minutes.

Penalty of Wrong Answer: There is a negative marking of 0.50 Marks for each wrong answer. There is no sectional cut off. No point will be deducted if the question is left blank or unattempted by a candidate.

TIER – 2 (Computer Based): SSC - CGL exam will be conducted online comprising of 4 sections with about a 100 questions in each section and with maximum marks of 200.

Penalty of Wrong Answer: There is a negative marking of 0.25 Marks for each wrong answer. There is no sectional cut off. No point will be deducted if the question is left blank or unattempted by a candidate.

TIER – 3 (Pen and Paper Mode): SSC CGL will be a descriptive test. The paper will be in English/Hindi and will constitute of 100 marks. The entire paper needs to be completed in 60 minutes.

Tier-4 Exam Pattern

SSC CGL Tier-4 Exam is a Computer Skill Test. It will be conducted in two steps: DEST Test & CPT Test.

DEST: Candidates are required to type 2000 words in 15 minutes on a computer in English. This test is conducted to check a candidate's writing skills.

CPT: This test is conducted to check a candidate's proficiency in Word Processing, Spreadsheets and Generation of Slides.
